### ICP Common Entrance Exam for Subspecialty Fellowship Courses - July 2025 Session

The Indian College of Pediatrics (ICP), under the Indian Academy of Pediatrics (IAP), announces the Common Entrance Exam for Fellowship Courses for the session commencing in July 2025.

#### Important Dates

- Registration Start Date: 1 March 2025
- Registration End Date: 30 March 2025
- Admit Card Release Date: 10 to 15 April 2025 (Tentative)
- Exam Date: **11 May 2025 (Sunday)**

#### Required Documents

- Photograph: Soft copy (PDF/JPEG/PNG), max 175 KB
- Signature: Soft copy (PDF/JPEG/PNG), max 175 KB
- MBBS Marksheet of the last 2 examinations held (called "final" and "pre-final")
- Copy of MBBS Marksheet: Final and Pre-final
- Payment Options: UPI/Credit/Debit card

#### Exam Structure

- Mode: Online (Computer-Based Test - CBT)
- Duration: 3 hours
- Number of Questions: 100 Multiple-Choice Questions (MCQs)
- Eligibility Criteria: MD/DNB/DCH in Pediatrics
  - Candidates must have their degree by May 20, 2025, to be eligible for counselling and allotment.
  - It is the responsibility of the candidate to ensure eligibility.
- Application Fee: INR 2500 + GST + Transaction charge

#### Admit Card Details

- Admit cards will be available from **April 10-15, 2025 (Tentative)** on **Official website**.
- A **printed admit card** and **valid photo ID** are required at the exam Center.

#### Examination Centres

- The examination will be conducted in person at six test centres across India: **Delhi, Mumbai, Chennai, Bengaluru, Hyderabad, and Kolkata**. *(If any case, the minimum number of Applicants are not there the centre may be deleted and prior intimation will be provided to the Applicant)*
- Candidates can choose **two centres** (in order of preference) during registration. While efforts will be made to allot the preferred centre, logistics may necessitate an alternate allotment.

**Merit Tie-Breaking Criteria** In case of tied scores, the merit order will be determined by the following, in that order:

1. Final Year MBBS Percentage
2. Pre-final MBBS Percentage
3. Age (Older candidates ranked higher)

### Counselling Process

- The counselling process consists of three rounds, each lasting 10 days.
- The process would commence on 20<sup>th</sup> May and end by 20<sup>th</sup> June.
- The candidates shall indicate their course preferences after the declaration of the merit list.
- All candidates who appear in the exam and score more than 25<sup>th</sup> percentile will qualify in the merit list.
- The entire allotment process will be online.

### Counselling Process Guidelines

- All candidates who qualify in the merit list would be considered for the allotment process.
- Candidates must use the registered mobile number/email ID for counselling, as OTPs will be sent to those details.
- The order of seat allocation will be based on rank and college preferences selected by candidates.
- The candidate shall have the option of "ACCEPT", "SLIDE" & REJECT.

### Instructions for Candidates Allotted a Seat in the 1<sup>st</sup> Round

#### Option 1: Accept the Allotted Seat

- Once a candidate accepts the seat, that seat is frozen for that particular candidate.
- A non-refundable fee of INR 5,000 must be paid upon acceptance towards ICP registration charges. This fee is for that particular position and is non-refundable and non-transferable.
- The candidate shall have 5 days to report to the allotted institute.
- After accepting the position, if the candidate does not want to join the centre, she/he has to inform the centre and ICP within these 5 days. The candidate would then be eligible for next round of allotment.
- If the candidate fails to report within the designated time, the seat will be reallocated in the next round, and the fee forfeited. The candidate shall not be eligible for further allotment process.

#### Option 2: SLIDE (Participate in the 2<sup>nd</sup> Round)

- Candidates opting for the SLIDE option will be automatically eligible for the second round of allotment.
- The allotted seat is vacated for the next eligible candidate.

### Policies Regarding Eligibility for 2<sup>nd</sup> Round

- Candidates who select SLIDE in the 1<sup>st</sup> round and fulfilled the requirements are eligible for the 2<sup>nd</sup> round.
- Candidates who were considered in the 1<sup>st</sup> round but were not allotted any seat will automatically be eligible for the next round.
- Candidates eligible for the 1<sup>st</sup> round but who did not register or fill choices shall still be considered eligible for the 2<sup>nd</sup> round.
